

Instructions Guidelines for the 2009 Student Paper Competition

The AIS Educator Association (AISEA) is pleased to announce the 2009 Student Paper Competition. This competition is intended to recognize outstanding work by graduate students of accounting information systems. This competition is funded through a generous donation by the AISEA Founders, Jack and Maye Stewart.

The student who submits the winning paper will receive a \$1,000 cash award upon attending the AIS educator's conference and presenting the paper. This year's annual conference will be held at the Marriott in Colorado Springs, Colorado, from June 26 through June 28, 2009.

Paper topics may include but are not limited to:

- AIS educational research
- Control and auditing systems
- Database systems, enterprise systems
- E-commerce, expert systems, artificial intelligence
- Decision aids, knowledge management
- Financial reporting systems
- General AIS frameworks
- Internet and WWW systems
- Organization and management of IS
- Systems implementation issues
- XBRL

THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSIONS IS MARCH 1, 2009. The paper will be subjected to a blind review process. Notification to participating students will be made by April 15, 2009.

Document Preparation

The paper should follow the submission style guidelines available on the AIS Educator Association web site at www.aiseducators.com. Select the Conference Info, Submission, and Submission Style Guidelines links. Select a file name that reflects the name of the paper rather than the author. Remove other identifiers of the author or school from the document.

Electronic Submission

The paper should be submitted through the AIS Educator Association web site. Select the Conference Info, Submission, and Manage My Submissions Online links. Select Student Paper in the Submission Type box.
